THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLEARVIEW

A By-Law to amend Schedule "A" of By-Law Number 06-23 Being a Bylaw to Provide for Fire and Emergency Services Fees and Charges

WHEREAS, The Municipal Act provides for Municipalities to establish fees for services and activities provided or done by the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase a number of various fees for services and activities provided or done by the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, The Township of Clearview has entered into an agreement with Fire Marque Inc. to recover fire response fees;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Clearview enacts as follows:

1. That the fees for certain services provided by the Clearview Fire Department shall be according to Schedule "A" of this By-Law.
2. That Schedule "A" of By-Law Number 06-23 is hereby amended by By-Law Number 14-14;
3. That Schedule "A" forms part of this By-law.
3. That this By-Law shall come into force and effect on the date of the final passing thereof.

By-Law Number 14-14 read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 27th day of January, 2014.
