

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLEARVIEW

BY-LAW NO. 15-22

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE BLANKET ENDORSEMENT OF ROOF-TOP SOLAR FACILITIES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF CLEARVIEW IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO'S FEED-IN-TARIFF PRIORITY POINT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS the Province's FIT Program encourages the construction and operation of rooftop solar PV generation projects (the "Projects");


AND WHEREAS one or more Projects may be constructed and operated in the Corporation of the Township of Clearview;


AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the FIT Rules, applicants whose Projects receive the formal support of local municipalities will be awarded Priority Points, which may result in these applicants being offered a FIT Contract prior to other persons applying for FIT Contracts;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLEARVIEW HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the purposes of procuring priority points under the Province of Ontario's FIT 2015 Priority Point System, Council supports without reservation, any project to install a roof-top solar power facility on an existing structure within the Township of Clearview; and further,
2. **THAT** the sole purpose of Council's endorsement is to enable FIT applicants to receive Priority Points for roof-top solar projects and shall not be construed as an approval or expression of support in any other regard; and further,
3. **THAT** Council's blanket endorsement pertaining to FIT 2015 shall expire twelve (12) months after its adoption by Council; and further,
4. **THAT** this blanket endorsement does not constitute the Township's acceptance of any liability or responsibility for any given project; and further,
5. **THAT** any roof-top solar project installed in the Township must comply with all applicable local and Provincial policy and legislation, including but not limited to the Ontario Building Code.
6. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect upon being passed by Council.

Read a first, second, and third time and finally passed this the 23rd day of March, 2015.
