



Sewage System Permit Inspections

During the course of construction, the Building Inspector must be contacted at the completion of each of the following phases so that the Inspector can make these inspections in accordance with the Building By-Law.

Sewage System Inspections

- 1) Site Assessment: During the permit application phase prior to issuance of the building permit notice is required that (2) two test holes 5 feet deep have been dug in area of proposed leaching bed for evaluation.
- 2) Final Inspection: when installation is complete but before it is covered, under no circumstances may an installation be covered before the required inspection is made. The contractor must be on site and provide a surveyor's level and rod for inspection
- Occupancy of the Structure: will not be permitted until the complete system has been inspected and the location of the water supply and buildings has been verified.

Requesting Inspections

When requesting inspections, please quote Building Permit Number and allow a minimum of 48 hours' notice.

Please note that if an inspection is requested prematurely an additional inspection fee may be required.
